*Location and Directions:* Westminster Presbyterian Church: 3639 Old Chapel Hill Road, Durham (corner of Shannon Drive)

From Raleigh, take I-40 to the 15-501 exit; turn right onto 15-501, towards Durham. When the road divides, keep left (Business 15-501). About 2 1/2 miles from I-40, just past South Square Shopping Center, turn right onto Shannon (the 5th light from I-40; Office Depot will be on your right); it will dead end at Old Chapel Hill Road. Cross Old Chapel Hill Road to go directly into the church driveway. Go to the Music Room, on the 2nd floor of the Education Building (the middle building). From Chapel Hill, take 15-501 towards Durham, and see directions above.

*Costs:* For members, meeting fees are \$5.00. For non-members, the first visit is free; subsequent meetings are \$7.00. Our newest anthology is \$12.00 for members and \$15.00 for non-members. Pat will have them available for purchase.
