Location and Directions:

Westminster Presbyterian Church: 3639 Old Chapel Hill Road, Durham (corner of Shannon Drive)

From Raleigh, take I-40 to the 15-501 exit; turn right onto 15-501, towards Durham. When the road divides, keep left (Business 15-501). About 2 1/2 miles from I-40, just past South Square, turn right onto Shannon (the 5th light from I-40; Office Depot will be on your right); it will dead end at Old Chapel Hill Road. Cross Old Chapel Hill Road to go directly into the church driveway. From Chapel Hill, take 15-501 towards Durham, and see directions above. Look for signs to the meeting room to be posted outside of the church.

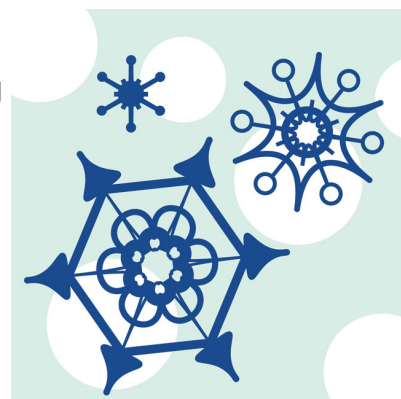
