Your TRS Music Library—Come USE IT!

Come sift through the collected treasures of the TRS Music Library, now housed at Pearson Music Studios! It is accessible Mon. through Fri. 10:00 am - 7:00 pm and Sat. 9:00 am - 6:00 pm. (The directions to the Studios are on trianglerecorder.org)

The Library is located in the back hall of the Studios, and you may sit in the hall browsing for as long as you like. Depending on the time of day, you may need to enter the building through the front or side door.

You may use an empty teaching studio to play through any music you like. There may be a music stand available, but to be on the safe side, bring your own. If you play for more than a few minutes, the Studios would really appreciate your paying \$8 for each 30 minutes of studio playing time. You may also use a teaching studio (or the reception area on late Saturday afternoons) for groups to play together. For groups, the same rate of \$16/hour will apply. It is hoped that these charges will not be in any way prohibitive of your utilizing the Library, but that you will understand that the light, heat, water, and sewer bills must be paid in addition to the building rent in order to keep this business open. You may give payment to either Mary or Bobby at the store.

Please completely fill out the sign-out form for any music you take home; we don't want to lose track of anything. There is no set period of check-out time, but please don't make it too long. The Library is very accessible now, so you may always borrow it again!

Please add your comments on the music using Post-It notes, a sheet of paper tucked inside the music, or lightly in pencil on a non-music page! You might indicate the level of difficulty, tell everyone how many stars (out of five) you would give it, or make other noteworthy comments.
