## *TRS Playing Meeting November 19, 2:30-5:00 in Durham*

Join us for the November meeting on November 19 in Durham at in Durham, at Westminster Presbyterian Church.

### *Location and directions:*

We will meet in the music room of Westminster Presbyterian Church in Durham. It is located at 3639 Old Chapel Hill Road, on the corner of Shannon Drive.

From Raleigh, take I-40 to the 15-501 exit; turn right onto 15-501, towards Durham. When the road divides, keep left (Business 15-501). About 2 1/2 miles from I-40, just past South Square Shopping Center, turn right onto Shannon (the 5th light from I-40; Office Depot will be on your right); it will dead end at Old Chapel Hill Road. Cross Old Chapel Hill Road to go directly into the church driveway. Go to the Music Room, on the 2nd floor of the Education Building (the middle building).

From Chapel Hill, take 15-501 towards Durham, and see directions above.

### *Costs:*

For members, meeting fees are \$5.00. For non-members, the first visit is free; subsequent meetings are \$7.00.

**Sacred Music, Early and Modern: Featuring works by Claudio Monteverdi (1567-1643), Arvo Pärt (b. 1935) and Duke graduate composer Paul Leary**

**PROGRAM:**

Claudio Monteverdi, *Cantate Domino, Adoramus te, a 4-voice Mass and several 3-voice motets from Monteverdi's 1582 publication*

Arvo Pärt, *Bogoroditse Djevo, Spiegel im Spiegel*  
Paul Leary (graduate student composer), *Sanctus*

The Collegium Musicum is Duke's ensemble for early music. In this concert, the group performs early music and modern music that is written in the spirit of early music. The works of the great Italian composer Claudio Monteverdi are familiar territory for the Collegium. Monteverdi, a prolific and innovative composer working at the end of the Renaissance, introduced new stylistic elements that looked forward to the musical Baroque.

Arvo Pärt, a 20th century Estonian composer, spent the first part of his career working in a Soviet-dominated society where overtly Christian themes in music were discouraged. Pärt persevered, writing music on sacred themes that melded his love of the Baroque style with 20th century musical sensibilities.

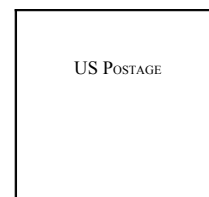
