## Join us on October 18

The October 18 playing meeting will be held at Westminster Presbyterian in Durham. We will be led by Patricia Petersen. We have a new anthology, *Aspects of Love*, from Eric Haas. Everyone please practice p. 3 & p. 36. If you do not have the new anthology, they will be available! Beginners are welcome; Doug Young will be available to coach.



*Location and directions:* We will meet in the music room of Westminster Presbyterian Church in Durham. It is located at 3639 Old Chapel Hill Road, on the corner of Shannon Drive. From Raleigh, take I-40 to the 15-501 exit; turn right onto 15-501, towards Durham. When the road divides, keep left (Business 15-501). About 2 1/2 miles from I-40, just past South Square Shopping Center, turn right onto Shannon (the 5th light from I-40; Office Depot will be on your right); it will dead end at Old Chapel Hill Road. Cross Old Chapel Hill Road to go directly into the church driveway. Follow signs to the music room upstairs in the education building.

*Costs:* For members, meeting fees are \$5.00. For non-members, the first visit is free; subsequent meetings are \$7.00. The price of the new anthology is \$10 for members/\$12 for non-members.
